ionianMode HQ is located right next to Lygia Port, 10' from Lefkas town centre, 30' from Aktion Airport and 4h30' from Athens Eleftherios Venizelos International Airport.

From Lefkas town centre and Aktion Airport, taxi or minibus transfer is suggested.

From Athens Eleftherios Venizelos International Airport, use of bus service (KTEL) is suggested. It takes 60' via bus X93 (departing every 40') to reach main bus station and then another 4h30' to the Lefkas town station.





DESCRIPTION

The practical courses are 5 day courses beginning on Monday 09.00 and ending on Friday 18.00 with a free sail day on Saturday. Candidates are expected to be at our base on Sunday night at the latest, where they will be welcomed by their instructor and briefed about the yacht and the course.



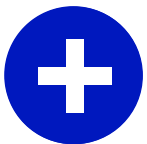
ACCOMMODATION

Depending on your reservation and the yacht that it will be used for the course you will be accommodated on a bunk bed, or a double bed cabin or saloon berth. Accommodation may be shared and saloon berths may be used. The size of our tuition yachts is 36ft to 46ft, 3 – 4 cabins and 1 – 2 heads. All of our tuition yachts are fully coded, very well maintained, relatively new (oldest 2008 newest 2018), fully equipped and comply with the Greek and International safety regulations.



FOOD ON BOARD

A variety of local fresh products will be available at any time on the yacht during the course.
